



SOUTH & SOUTH-WEST

Asprokavos

- Atmosphere: Quiet, remote, but just outside of Kavos, which is very touristic in summer months
 - High season: July/August
 - Touristic/local: Little locals
 - Restaurants: Limited (some tavernas)
 - Beach: Natural, vast
- ✓ *Perfect for hikers*
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Paramonas

- Atmosphere: Quiet, local
 - High season: A bit busier in August, but never crowded
 - Touristic/local: More Greek than touristic
 - Restaurants: 2 very good tavernas (fish, local)
 - Beach: Beautiful bay, sand + pebbles, clear water
- ✓ *Top for food and beach without crowds*
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Santa Barbara (Agios Georgios South / Marathias)

- Atmosphere: Open, relaxed
 - High season: Enough space, never crowded
 - Touristic/local: Beach tourism, little village life, because the actual village is situated 2 km inland
 - Restaurants: Beach-tavernas
 - Beach: Long and wide sandy beach
- ✓ *Ideal for sun and swimming*
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WEST COAST (NATURE & SUNSET)

Pelekas

- Atmosphere: Authentic village, magnificent sunset
- High season: Medium crowd
- Touristic/local: Mixed, rather authentic
- Restaurants: A number of good tavernas in the village
- Beach: Close by (Glyfada, Kontogialos, Myrtiotissam Yialiskari)

Beautiful village and beach at 3 km

Agios Georgios Pagon

- Atmosphere: Spacious, relaxed
- High season: Crowded in July & August
- Touristic/local: Touristic but quiet
- Restaurants: A number of good tavernas at the sea side
- Beach: Large sandy beach, clear water

Nice beach area without party buzz, except during summer months

Liapades

- Atmosphere: Traditional village with cosy square
- High season: During the day crowded at the beach, relatively quiet in the village
- Touristic/local: More authentic than most beach villages
- Restaurants: Small but good
- Beach: Spectacular (bays, clear water)

Nature, snorkeling, peace and quiet

NORTH & NORTH-EAST (MOST BEAUTIFUL BAYS)

Barbati

- Atmosphere: Stlish
 - High season: Very crowded in July and August
 - Touristic/local: Mostly touristic, not an authentic village
 - Restaurants: Good beach-restaurants
 - Beach: Pebble beach, very clear water
 - ✓ *Swimming, snorkeling, peace and quiet*
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Kalami

- Atmosphere: Charming, idyllic small bay, lots of small beaches in the close vicinity
 - High season: Crowded at day time, quiet in the evening; except between mid June and mid September
 - Touristic/local: Touristic but charming
 - Restaurants: Excellent tavernas at the sea side
 - Beach: Small bay, perfect water
 - ✓ *Romantic & quiet*
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Kassiopi

- Atmosphere: Lively harbour town
 - High season: Crowded in July/August
 - Touristic/local: Touristic but cozy in the season. Also inhabited in winter, so a real local village
 - Restaurants: Lots of choice, especially around the harbour
 - Beach: Small pebble beaches
 - ✓ *Coziness without clubscene*
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CROWD LEVEL & SEASON AT A GLANCE

Period	Crowd level	Notes
July-August	● High season	Warm, busier, especially in Liapades, Agios Georgios, Roda, Barbati & Kassiopi
June & September	● Ideal	Everything is open, more quiet
April, May & October	● Quiet	Local, nature, less open
November until March	○ Very quiet	Many shops and restaurants closed
